

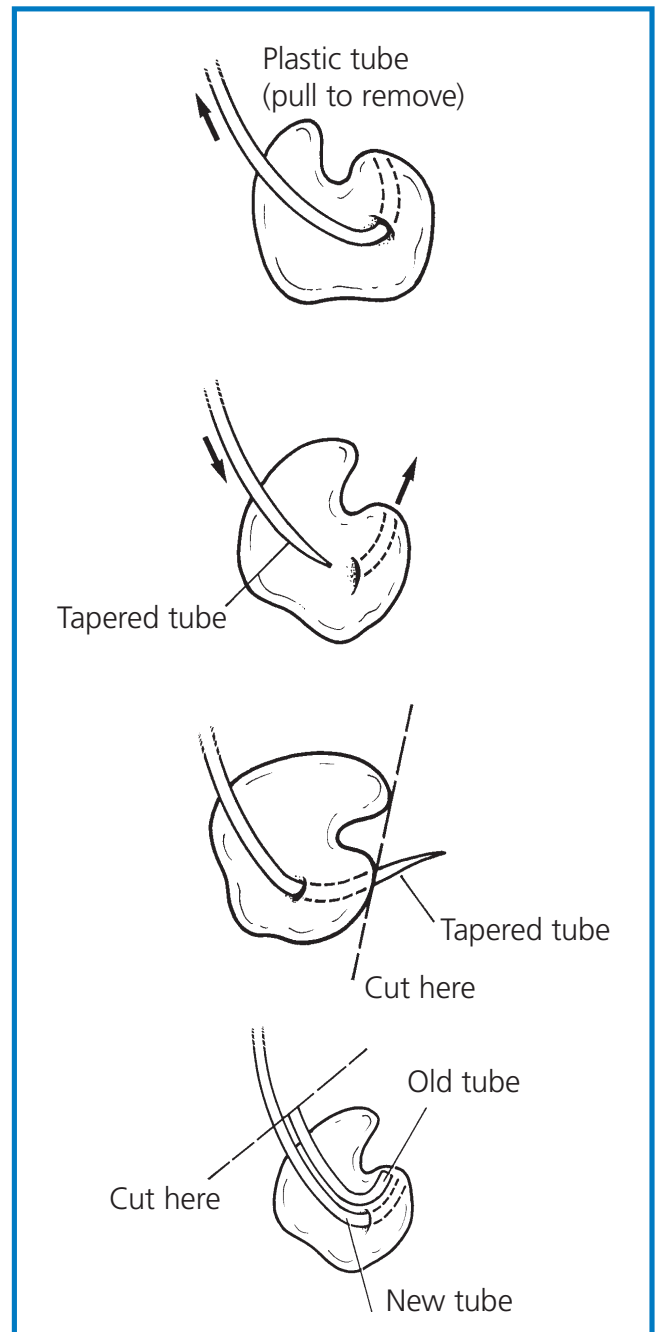
How to retube your earmould

i Information for patients Hearing Services

After 3-4 months, the flexible tube in your earmould needs to be replaced. This can be done as follows:

1. Pull the flexible tube out of the mould and keep it - you will need it later.
2. Take a piece of tubing and taper the last 25mm (1 inch).
You can now thread this all the way through the hole of the earmould from the flat side.
3. Pull the point of the tubing which emerges until all of the tapered end has been pulled through.
Cut this end off with a pair of scissors.
4. Use the old piece of tubing which you removed to measure the correct length for the new piece.

If you are not sure about how to retube your earmould, bring it to a repair session so that an Audiology technician can replace the tube for you.
