

Covid-19 Guidance For People Receiving Community Health Services Support at Home

What you can expect from us to help keep you safe?

- All staff will wear appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) while we visit and care for you.
- Staff will conduct visits socially distanced where possible.
- We may contact you by phone or do a virtual consultation instead of visiting as part of your treatment programme.

What help do we need from you?

- Please let us know prior to any contact if you, or anyone you have been in contact with, have any signs of coronavirus (e.g. new cough, change to taste/smell or high temperature) OR had a positive Covid-19 test result.
- Please can you and anyone in your home at the time we visit wear a mask or face covering while we are in the house.
- Please keep the number of people in the room while we are visiting to a minimum.
- Please open a window or door to provide additional ventilation.
