

Important information about your appointment

We know that restrictions have been lifted in many places but we are caring for extremely vulnerable people who could still get very sick if they catch COVID19. For these very good reasons we are still required to ask you to:



Do not attend if you or any of your household have COVID or symptoms which could be COVID-19.



Do not enter the building earlier than 15 minutes before your appointment time.



Attend your appointment alone.



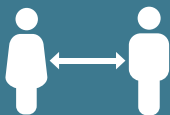
If you need someone to attend with you please only bring one person. They will need to wait outside until called in by staff to join you at the time of your appointment.
